Chapter 520–1, Vision No. 1

### VISION

<sup>(7)</sup> A voice in my ears,

<sup>(8)</sup> A calm, a solemn silence reigned during the time that this angel was in contemplation over the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) cup, a silence of half an hour.

<sup>(9)</sup> Then the silence was broken by the words of the twenty-four (24) elderly men,

**“Thou art worthy, Lord, our God, to exercise this judgment. Thou art worthy, Lord, our God.”**

<sup>(10)</sup> Then this impressive angel in service stood back up and took the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) cup with delicacy and handed it to the seventh man, clothed with white garments, with a golden belt upon his chest.

<sup>(11)</sup> After receiving the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) cup from the hand of this angel in service, the angel of the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) trumpet sounded it. Then rang out the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) thunder.
